### Contest Rules

- Traditional hand-painted or drawn posters can be completed on any sized paper and then must be photographed or scanned and submitted as **.pdf** or **.jpg** files to [info@tswcd.org](mailto:info@tswcd.org)
- Any media may be used, including paint, crayon, colored pencil, charcoal, stickers, paper, or other materials.
- All posters must be created by an individual student, rather than a team of students. Entry must be contestant's original creation and may not be traced from photographs or other artists' published works.
- The 2022 Stewardship theme “Healthy Soil: Healthy Life” must be included on the front side of each poster submission to be eligible for the national poster contest.
- Each poster entry must be submitted to TSWCD with an entry form to be eligible for judging. The form must be completed and signed by a parent or guardian.
- Although younger students will most likely receive help in planning from parents or teachers, NACD encourages each student to do their own work.

Note: Entries with student handwriting and coloring will score better than those designed, drawn, and colored by adult assistance
